PSE rate news alert -- December 1, 2017

On October 31st, 2017 and December 1, 2017, Puget Sound Energy filed requests with the state Utilities and Transportation Commission (UTC) to adjust electric and natural gas rates. The requested changes are proposed to be effective on January 1, 2018.

The overall average increase/decrease for electric and natural gas customers are as follows:
