LIBERTY ALERTS:

On Tuesday, Jan. 30th, 2018 the Whatcom County Council will address the removal of the moratorium imposed due to the WA State Supreme Court, Hirt Decision. With the passage of [ESSB-6091](#), the County Council has no excuses not to lift their self-imposed moratorium...but wait for it...they showed their intent and likely possibility that they will not fully comply with [the full faith of the new law due to the legislative Hirt fix by their questions at the recent Surface Water meeting](#).

Executive Louws has directed staff to bring forth an ordinance, with emergency effect, that will implement the law, as passed, by the legislature last week. It will have an immediate effective date and, theoretically, permits could be issued on Wednesday. **Executive Louws has directed staff to follow the current statute!**

However, Council members Rud Brown and Todd Donovan have asked the County Attorney to perform research on several items:

1. The ability of the County Council to enact an ordinance that would further limit the amount of water available from a well to something below 3,000 gal./day - the suggestion was 2,000 gallons or less
2. The ability of the County Council to place meters on new wells; and
3. The ability of the County Council to conduct discussions on these matters outside the view of the public - waiver of the open meetings act.

Talking with other council members and members of the public present at the meeting, there are four votes on the Council to pursue this action.

Introduction of Nick Adams: Born and raised in Australia, Nick Adams immigrated to America in 2016, with the United States government recognizing his 'extraordinary ability.' Nick's first challenge came at sixteen months. He was diagnosed with Stage IV Neuroblastoma (a rare form of childhood cancer) and given just a five percent chance of survival. He defied the odds, with a tenacity that would become a hallmark of his life. This early adversity indelibly shaped his life. As Nick wrote: *"It taught me to hope. It taught me to dream. That anything is possible. That no hurdle is too high, no burden too great and no obstacle insurmountable. That every day I breathe is a day that I am in credit, and I won't let a second go to waste."* Since these early trials, Nick has been blessed with great success in life. He attended the University of Sydney, earning both undergraduate and postgraduate degrees. While studying, he was publicly elected the youngest Deputy Mayor in Australian history in Sydney, at the age of twenty-one. Nick is a best-selling author, columnist and commentator, all achieved before he turned 30. He also currently serves as a surrogate for the White House.
